Introduction to Criminal Law in India

The course familiarizes the participants with the structure of criminal laws in India. Criminal laws in India are broadly categorized in two parts - substantial and procedural. The substantial law is the Indian Penal Code and procedural laws are the Criminal Procedure Code and Indian Evidence Act. Another category of laws is the local and special laws. This course aims at highlighting key characteristics and the extent to which they meet the changing demands of the society. The procedural law in India is the key instrument in protecting the rights of accused and victims for ensuring the fair trial.
